Company & Cultural Visits

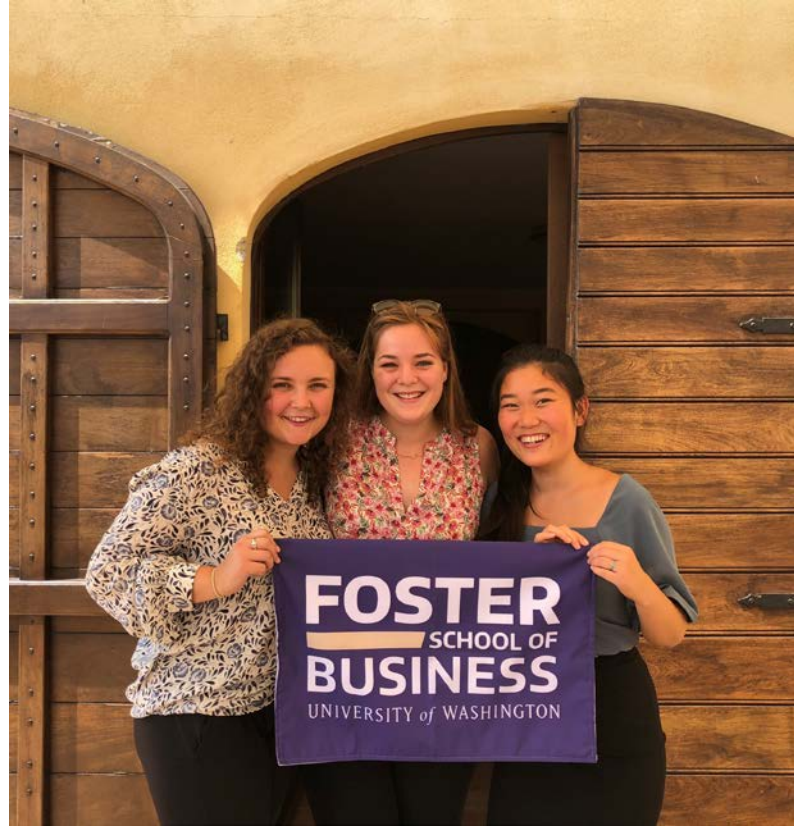
Students will visit 3 companies and 3 cultural sites as a group.

 - ECON 200
 - MATH 112 or 124 or equivalent
 - QMETH 201 or equivalent



Application Details

- Apply online by January 31, 2019

- Online application components:
 - Personal statement and short answer questions
 - Signature documents
 - Faculty/TA recommendation survey
 - Faculty/TA preferred, but you can also have an adviser fill it out
 - Must be requested by you before the deadline, but can be completed by recommender after the deadline
 - Just enter their email and they are sent details, it only takes a few minutes to fill out
- After the online applications are submitted, students will be emailed to come in for a group interview
